

Senior Guitar Ensemble


Friday 12.30 - 1pm in P12

Batik Workshop

Monday 3 - 4pm in CG5

Year 7.

Exploring the processes and techniques of traditional Batik. Batik is a process of using melted wax as a resist on fabric. The wax may be painted on a white or coloured fabric using a canting or brush or it may be stamped onto the fabric using a copper stamp dipped in melted wax. The fabric is then dyed, and the areas that have been waxed will not be penetrable by the dye.

Stop Motion Animation Workshop

Thursday 3 - 4pm in T12

Year 9.

Students will explore the photographic process of creating their own stop motion animation. Stop-motion animation is based on a simple process: objects are placed, photographed, and then repositioned. This process is repeated hundreds or thousands of times. When the pictures are rapidly viewed in sequence, the object appears to move.

All years.



Year 7.


